STUDENT CHECK LIST



Check the following lines to make sure that you have completed the five steps in getting started with your training as an Attending Student.

Step #1: ORIENTATION - All students must attend an Orientation Class held a week before classes begin (See the Class Schedule at the back of the Student Handbook for details).

Step #2: REGISTER – Make sure you fill out the registration form either online at www.somaschools.com or the paper copy in this packet.

Step #3: REGISTRATION FEE – There is a \$35 registration Fee due upon submitting your Registration.

Step #5: ASSIGNMENT - At the Orientation Class, secure your Study Bible and complete the assigned reading before the first class begins.


Step #6: ATTENDANCE: All Students will get started on the first Tuesday evening at 7PM after the January 1st.

BOOK REPORT



These are the instructions for required book reports that you will complete each year.

TITLE PAGE: On the title page please put your name, the title of the book and the date when it is due (Please consult the student Handbook for due dates).

INTRODUCTION: On page two, please write an introduction describing what the book is about. Save your opinions for later. For this section, simply state the facts. The introduction should not be over one page in length.

OUTLINE: Every book starts with an outline so you will endeavor to dissect each book to find its' original outline. Please follow the classic outline procedure, breaking each chapter down into its main points, indicated by Roman numerals. Each main point will further be broken down into upper case letters, then common numerals and finally, small case letters as follows:

CONCLUSION: The final page will state your opinion of the book. There are no right or wrong answers here, just your impressions of the subject matter, layout and style of the book.

DUE DATE: First Year book reports are due on the first day of classes for the Second and Third Trimesters (Classes 104 & 106. Second year books reports are due on the first day of classes for Courses 204 and 206.

Books will be distributed during Courses 102, 105, 202 & 205.



G R A D U A T I O N R E Q U I R E M E N T S



Every student must complete the following requirements for graduation from either the first or second year.

COMPLETE THE ASSIGNED BOOK REPORTS. There are two books a year that the students are required to read and

upon which to complete a book report.

COMPLETE ALL ASSIGNED WORK FOR EACH COURSE. There are eight courses a year with four requirements to complete each course:

(1) Attend or watch all four class lectures that make up each course

(2) Complete all of the reading assignments

(3) Answer all of the study questions with a passing grade (4) Record homework findings and take class notes

COMPLETE MINISTRY HOURS. All students are required to volunteer to serve in their local churches for a total of 100 hours per year.

TUITION PAID IN FULL. All students must have completed their tuition schedule before classes are finished



GRADUATION CEREMONIES: Our graduation ceremonies are held in December at Open Door Fellowship (3130 S. Bridge St., Chillicothe, Ohio 45601). All students are invited to participate. Students finishing their first year will receive a certificate of completion while second year students receive a mounted diploma.
